Peggy, **Tobacco**: Last High Country quit group is next Tuesday.

We are hoping to get Aaron trained in September to co-facilitate groups. It is in the tobacco budget to get 2 people in the county trained. The next HCBH Quit Tobacco group could start in November.

The County Attorney's Office is using In-Depth Tobacco interventions for youth with MIP for tobacco - Stephanie Sprenger would like to get trained in Botvin Life Skills to use with youth with MIP's for alcohol.

Trisha: Present Botvin Life Skills Training (LST) school tobacco and substance abuse prevention opportunities for K-12. SAFV prevention coordinator wants to get trained to implement LST in middle school health classes.

Sarah, **Youth Marijuana**: Wyoming Association of Municipalities (WAM) is debating a resolution to support "decriminalization of medical marijuana"; Town of Pinedale Mayor contacted the task force to learn more about what is available as medical marijuana in Wyoming. We were able to connect the Mayor to the COunty health Officer to educate the Mayor that Wyoming doctors and providers currently prescribe 4 FDA approved and regulated marijuana medications. Promote June 19th Prevention Series Delta-8 learning opportunity.

Janna **Rx**: Opioid settlement update. Narcan update. We are working with a treatment Court participant who wants to educate on Narcan and promote free distribution of Narcan.

Trisha, **Alcohol**: Share proposed images for summer moderate drinking media campaign. We will send images to the task force for feedback on the design.

Talk They Hear You and Fentanyl Awareness media reach increased by over a thousand views, when we paid to boost posts.
